- **All sections in the Eol template are addressed:**
  - 1) Scientific/technological case; 2) Partnership case; 3) Summary work-plan 4) Ethical Issues
- **You must remember to FINALIZE your submission in the online submission tool.**

## Read very carefully the Topic text:

- **All scientific objectives need to be addressed**
- **Work packages:**
  - The given structure is flexible and allows for innovative project design proposals.
  - The participants are expected to make key contributions on the defined deliverables in synergy with the EFPIA consortium.
- **EFPIA contribution:** it is *in kind* and will be refined during preparation of the FPP jointly with the selected Applicant consortium.
